

Product Description

LAXTER AR-305 is a hydroxyl group terminated branched aromatic polyester. This polyester is specially designed for rigid foam applications. This product can offer excellent dimensional stability and excellent flammability performance and may be used for systems which require a Class I rating in the ASTM E-84 tunnel burn test.

Storage and Handling

This product is hygroscopic and tends to absorb water which may adversely affect processing. Use of a dry nitrogen blanket for partial drums is recommended. This polyester can be stored at 158°F (70°C) under nitrogen blanket with slow agitation for 2 months or can be stored at 77°F (25°C) under nitrogen blanket for 1 year. In order to maintain liquid, this polyester should be stored above 59°F (15°C). This product is not damaged by freezing. However, it may freeze or separate due to cold. Warm to 158°F (70°C) to thaw and mix until uniform.
